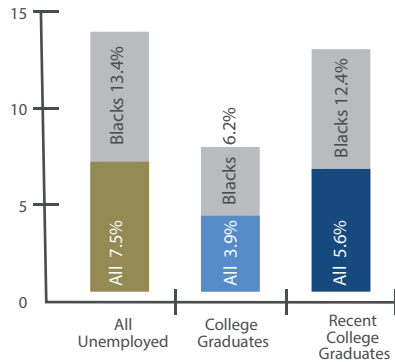


A College Degree is No Guarantee

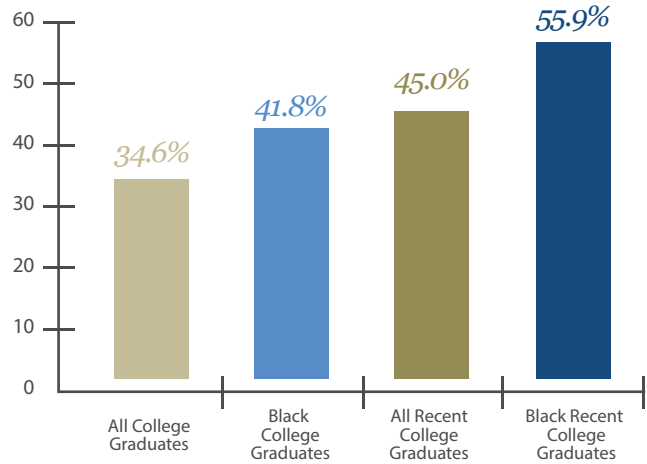
Unemployment Rates, 2013



Black workers have a much higher unemployment rate than average, but black college grads do much better than the average black worker.

Black recent college grads, however, are almost as likely to be unemployed as the average black worker.

Share of Graduates in Non-College Jobs, 2013



55.9 percent of black recent college graduates are in jobs that don't require a college degree.

Unemployment Rates, 2010 and 2013

The unemployment rate for black recent college grads is higher now than at the beginning of the economic recovery.

2010 6.5%

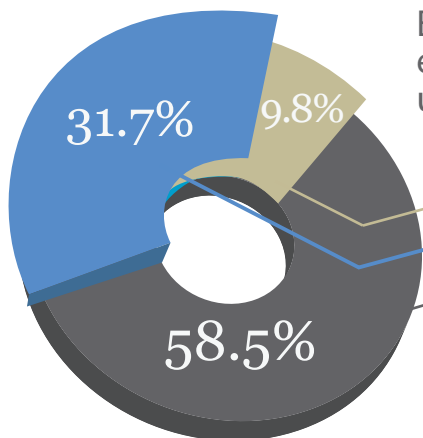
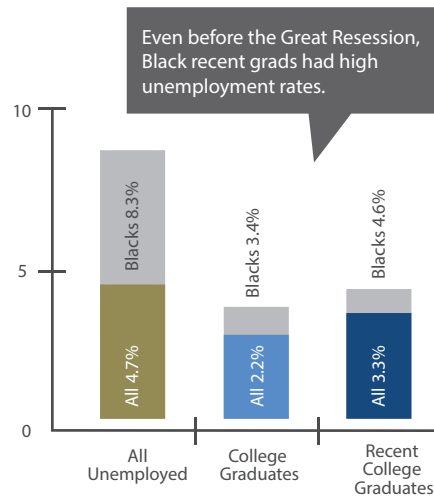
2013 5.6%
